REMEMBER

Opinion stories are about you discussing and reflecting on important issues. You can be more subjective than in a feature or news story. Usually, you quickly state the problem with the necessary facts and information, and then spend the bulk of time arguing for your standpoint.

Below you see a number of important criteria that can be used for your feature story:

- Uniqueness –unusual events and experiences
- Timeliness – events and experiences that are current, happening right now.
- Proximity – events that occur near the reader
- Importance – important to the reader's lives or surroundings (e.g. family, community)
- Impact – news that has an impact on the situation for the readers
- Prominence – well-known people, organization or institutions
- Suspense – events where the outcome is not known
- Progress – advances in science, medicine, or technology
- Conflict – people or groups that disagree
- Emotions – love, hate, fear, jealousy and similar
